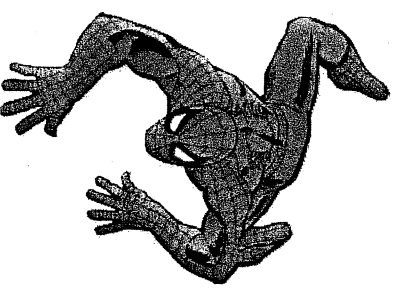

Classroom Norms

Hallway Norms

- We will keep our hands feet and unkind words to ourselves.
- We will have a pass from an adult to be in the hallway.
- We will go directly to our destination.
- We will follow adult directions.
- We will walk quietly, in a straight line on the RIGHT side of the hallway facing forward.
- We will walk at an appropriate pace.
- We will report any problems to an adult.

Bus Norms

- We will keep our hands feet and unkind words to ourselves.
- We will say "please," "thank you," and "excuse me."
- We will remain seated in our assigned seats while facing forward until the bus stops.
- We will quietly enter, ride, and exit the bus.
- We will leave the bus better than we found it, by keeping all food and drink items closed.
- We will report any graffiti, damages, or disturbances to an adult.
- We will make student and staff safety a priority at all times.

Cafeteria Norms

Behavior Management

Referral System:

Minor Offense - Teacher will handle along with call home.

Major Offense- Dream Coach will handle. Require written referral.

Fighting
Anything Sexual
Bullying
Stealing
Profanity/assault directed at staff
Weapons or drugs

Camp Referral Process

How do I get a referral?

Major violation such as, fighting, bullying, etc. (listed in previous slide).

What happens when I get one?

You'll pay a visit to Mrs. Allen, Mr. Medrano, or Mr. Blakey.

First Offense -Teacher will handle (Unless Major)

Re-teach norms, restorative conferences/circles, phone call home, conference with student.

Second Offense - Re-teach norms, restorative conference/circles, phone call home, conference with student, community service work, loss of all program privileges for a determined period of time.

Third Offense - Re-teach norms, restorative conference/circles, phone call home, conference with student, community service work, loss of all program privileges for a determined period of time, **A letter to return with parent**, Camper is considered for suspension or expulsion from summer camp.
